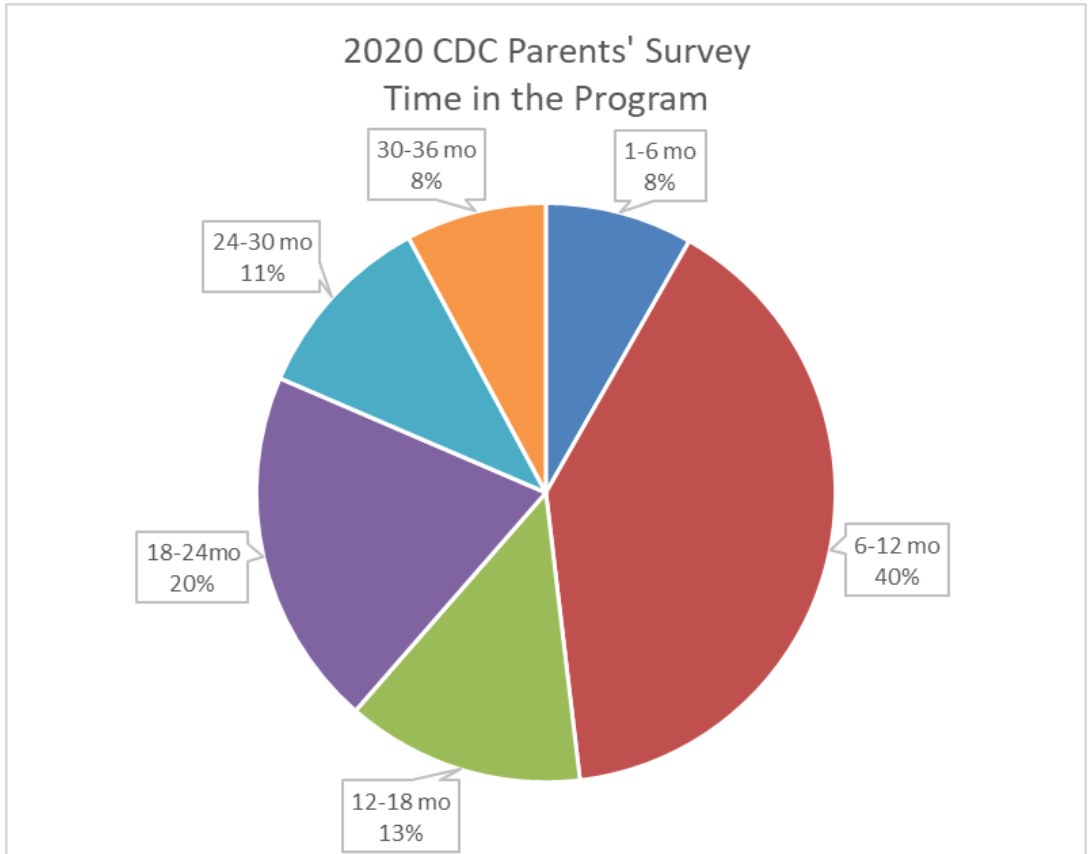
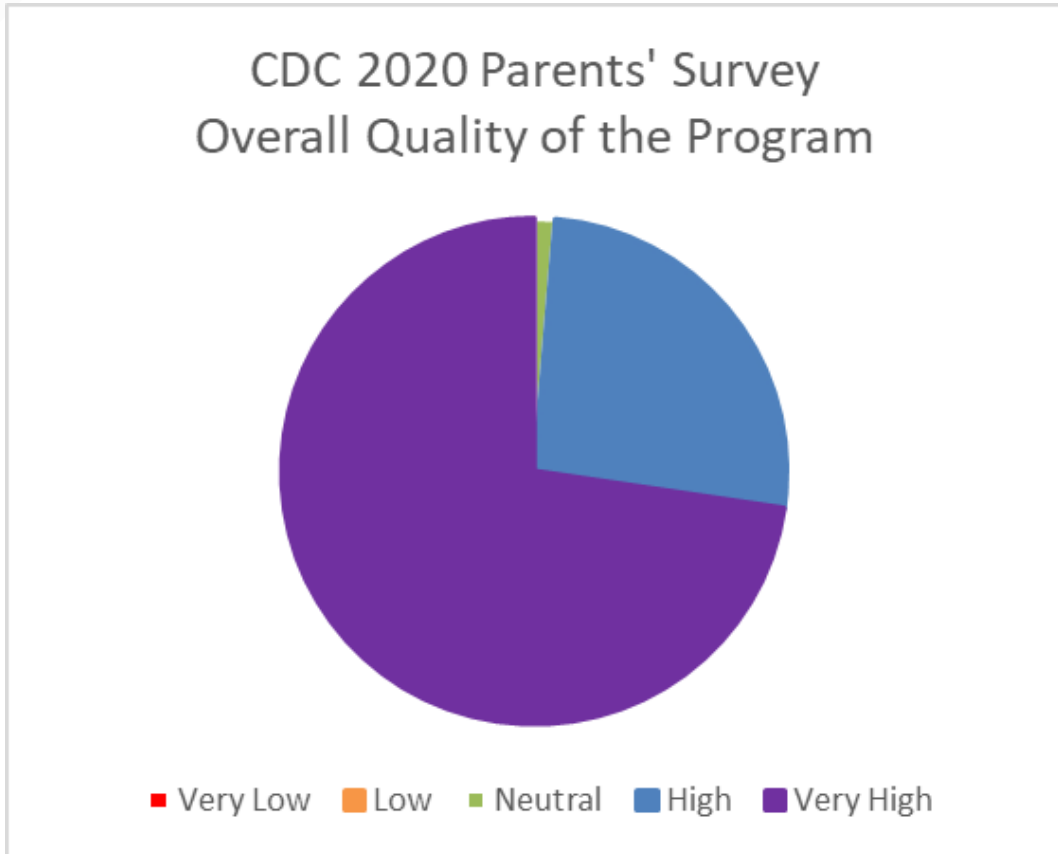

**535 Parents Responded**

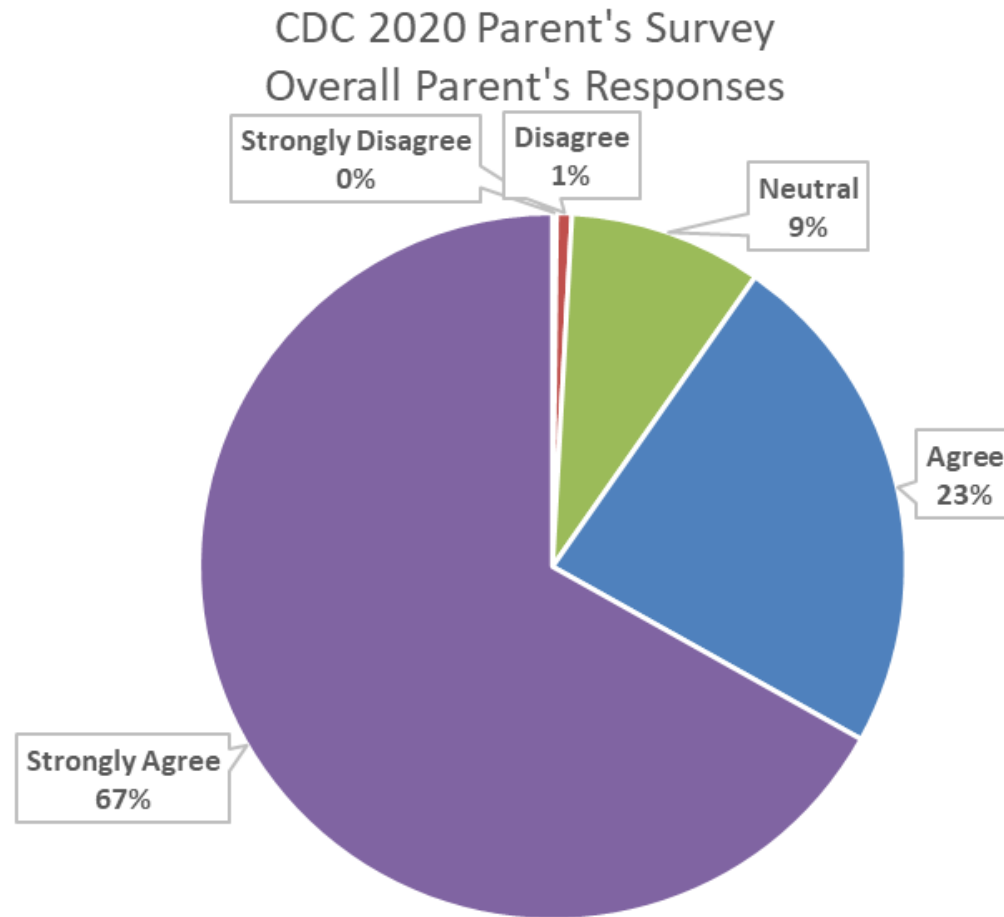
**99.6% Would Recommend the Program To Others!**

## 90% of Responses were Positive!

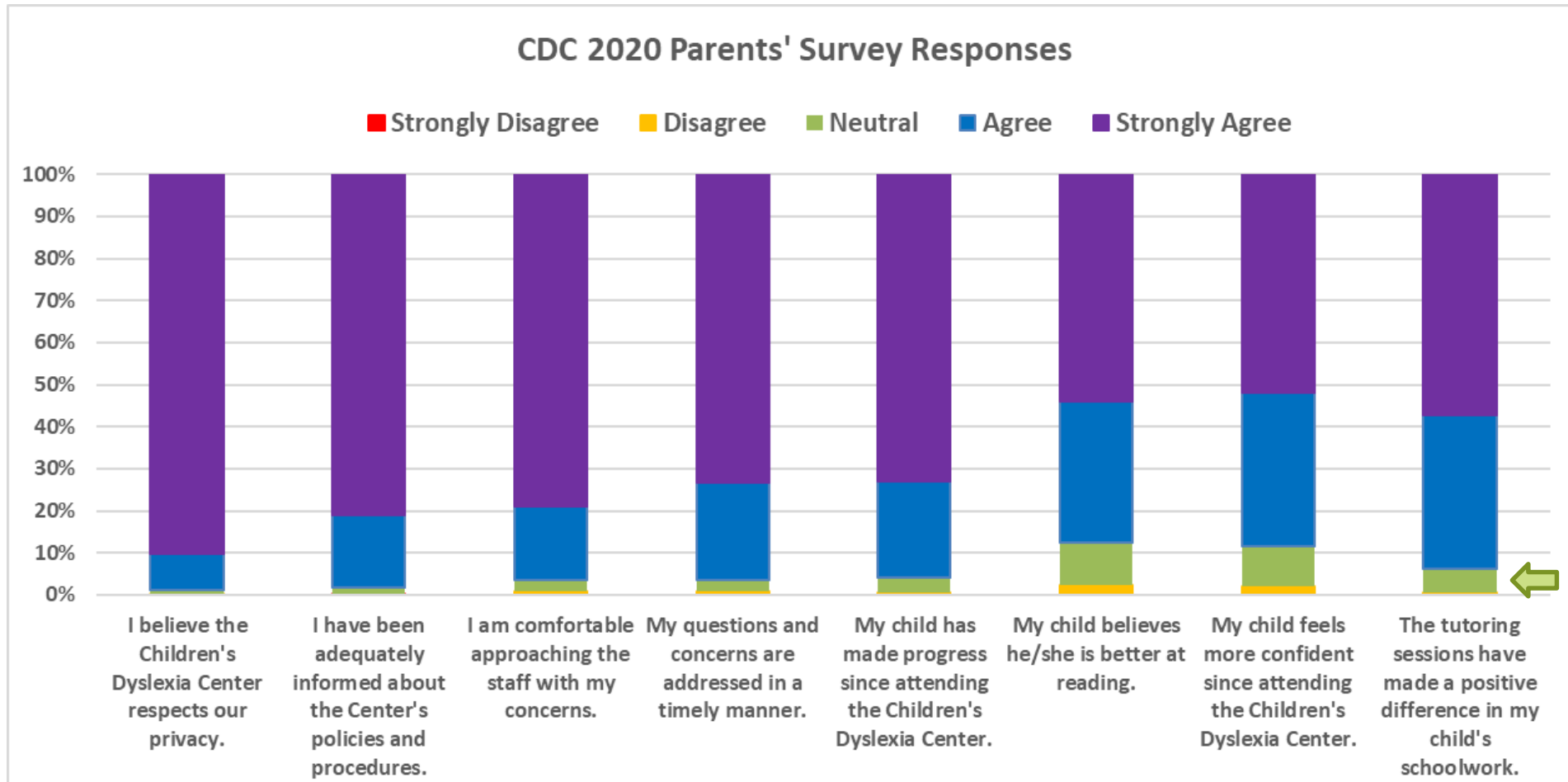




# Parent Survey Results

### 67% Strongly Agree



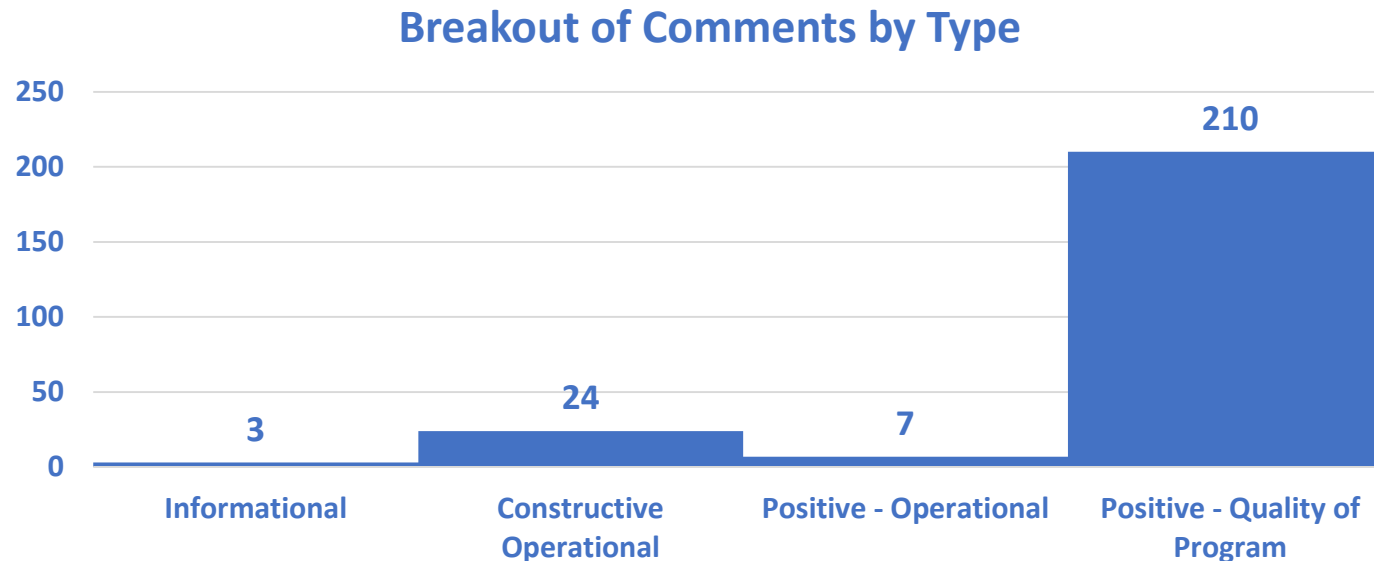
16 of 30 Neutral responses in the program less than 1 yr.

- It is to be noted – we **DID NOT RECEIVE** a single negative comment

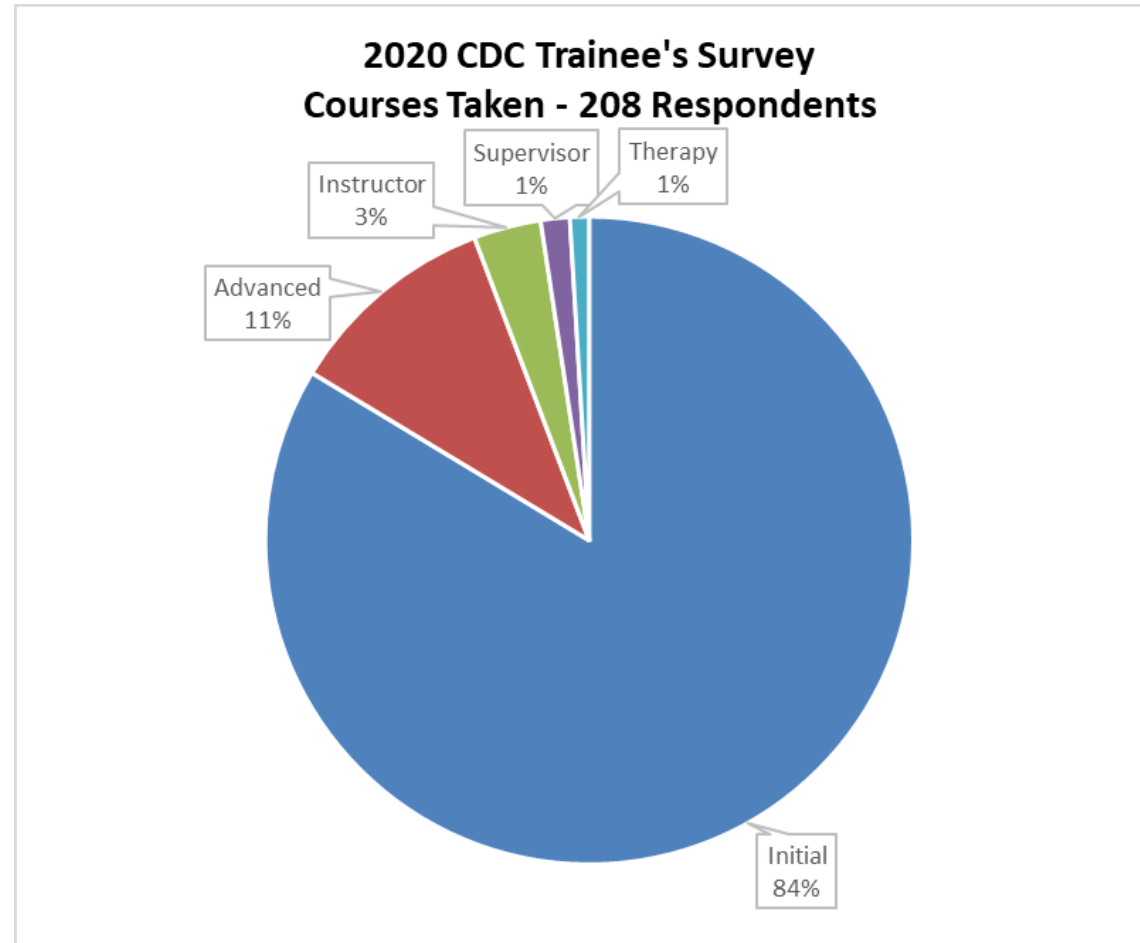


# Trainee Survey - Respondents

*Advanced, Supervisor, Instructor & Therapy Courses Combined on following charts*

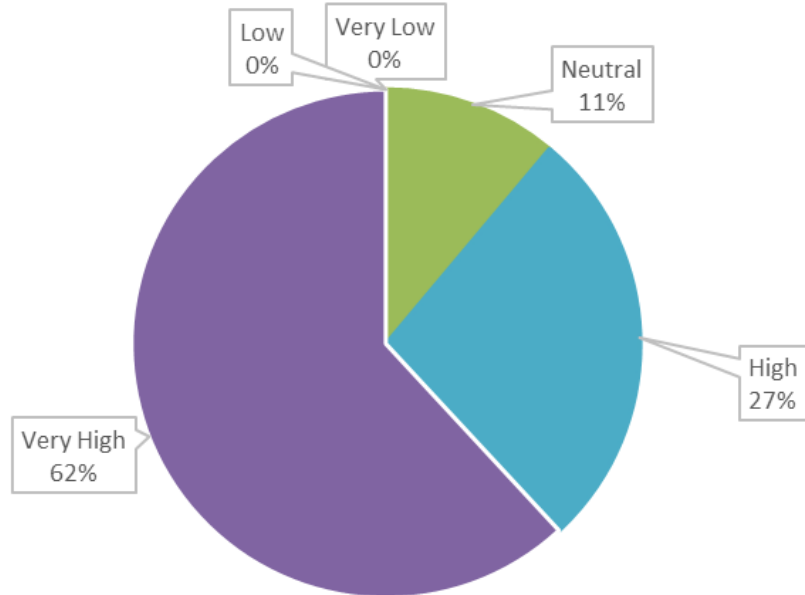


# Trainee Survey - Overall Quality

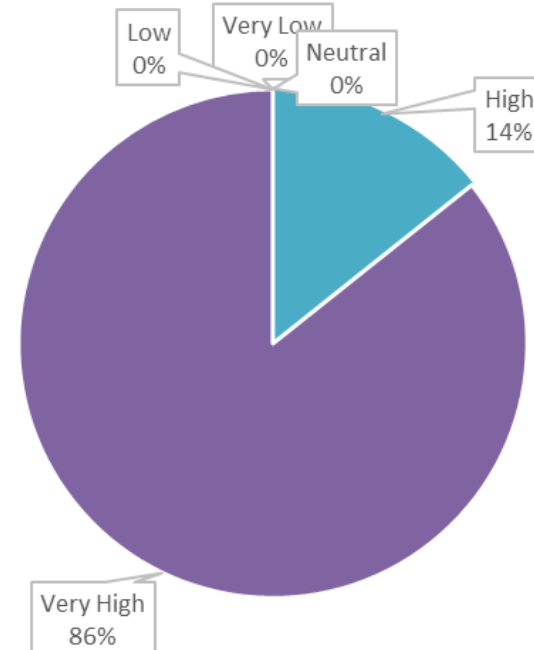

Quality of the Course - Initial Trainees



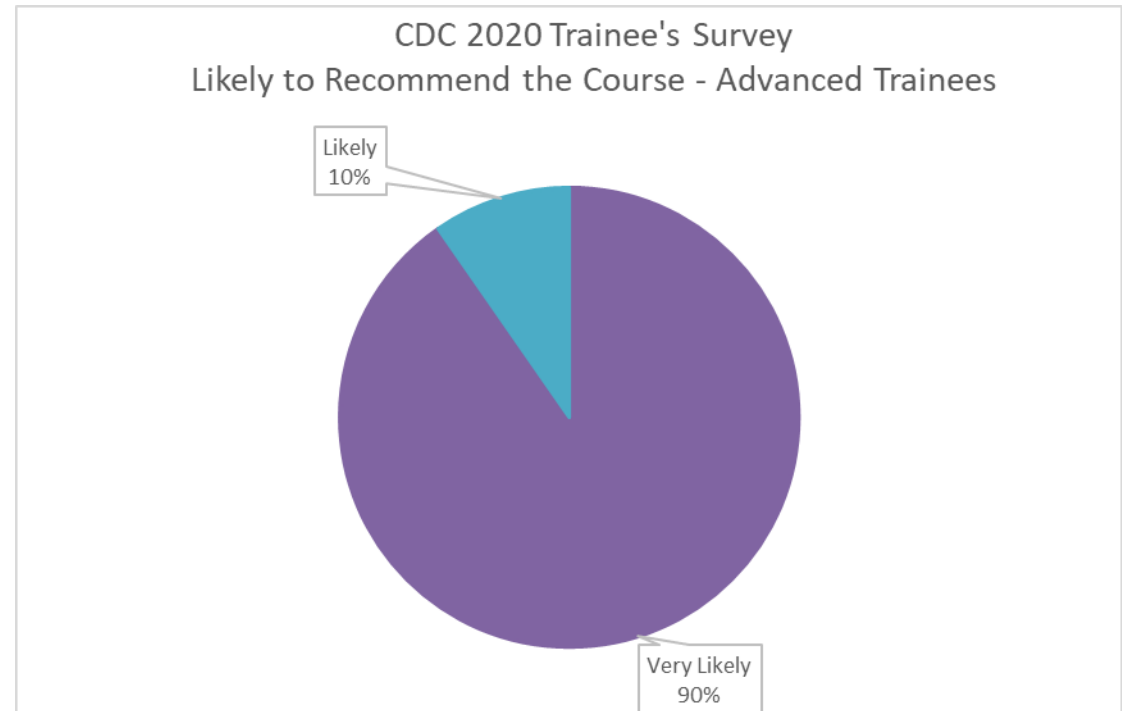
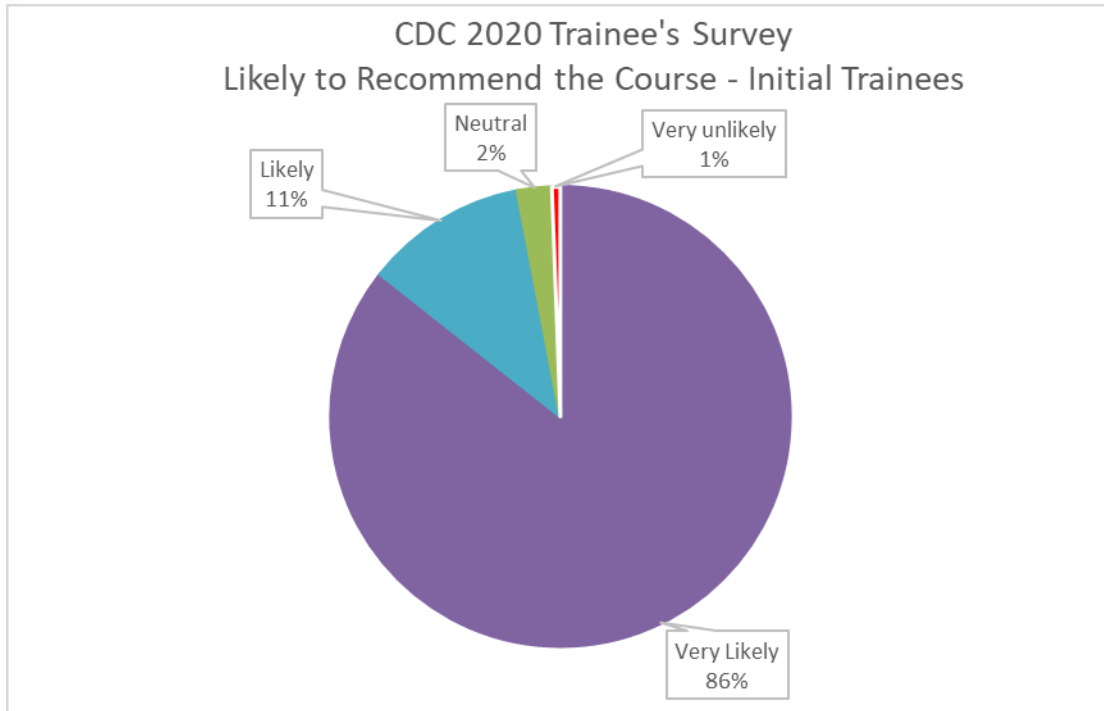

# Trainee Survey - Overall Quality



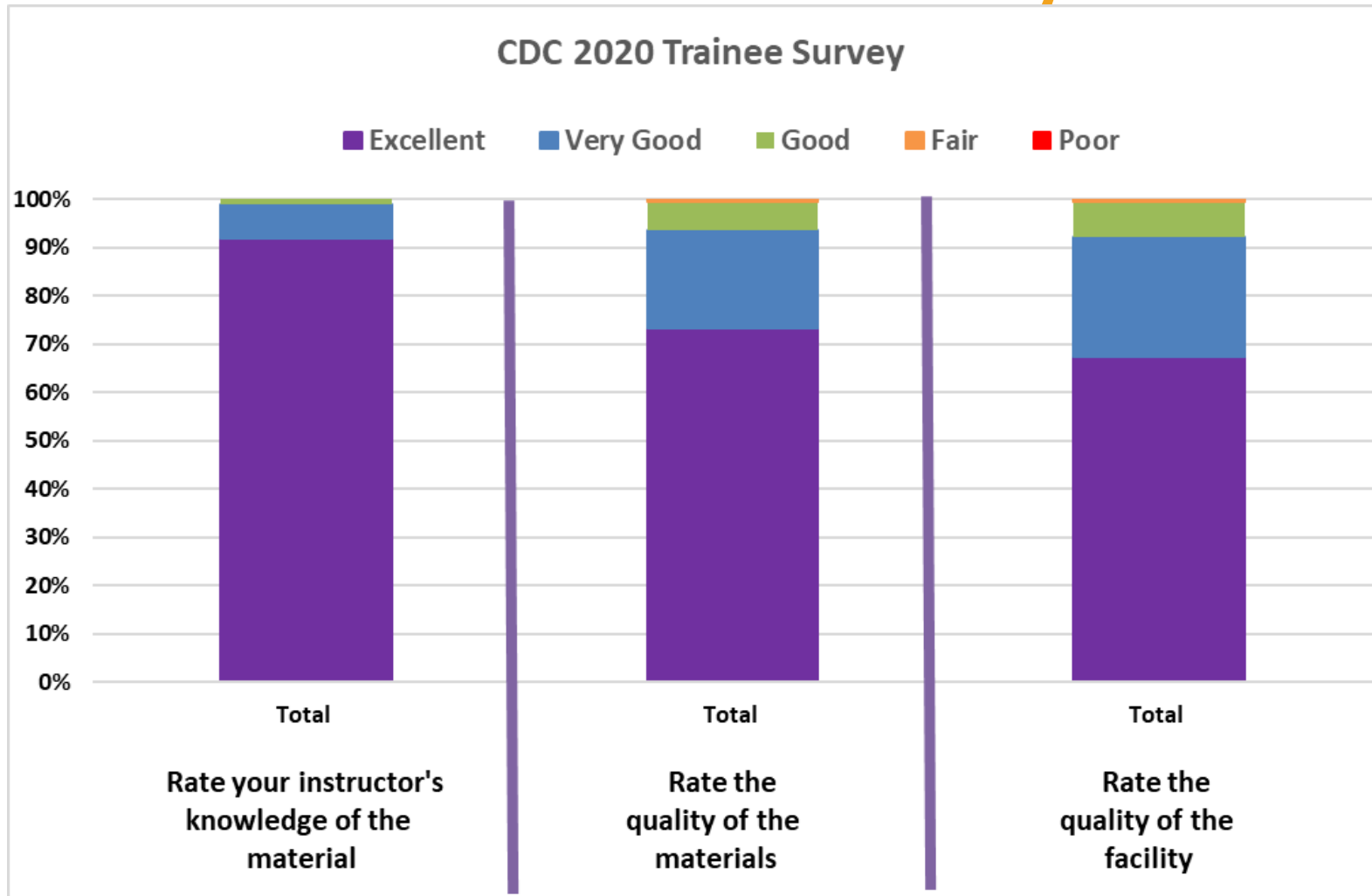
**86% Highly Likely to recommend the course**

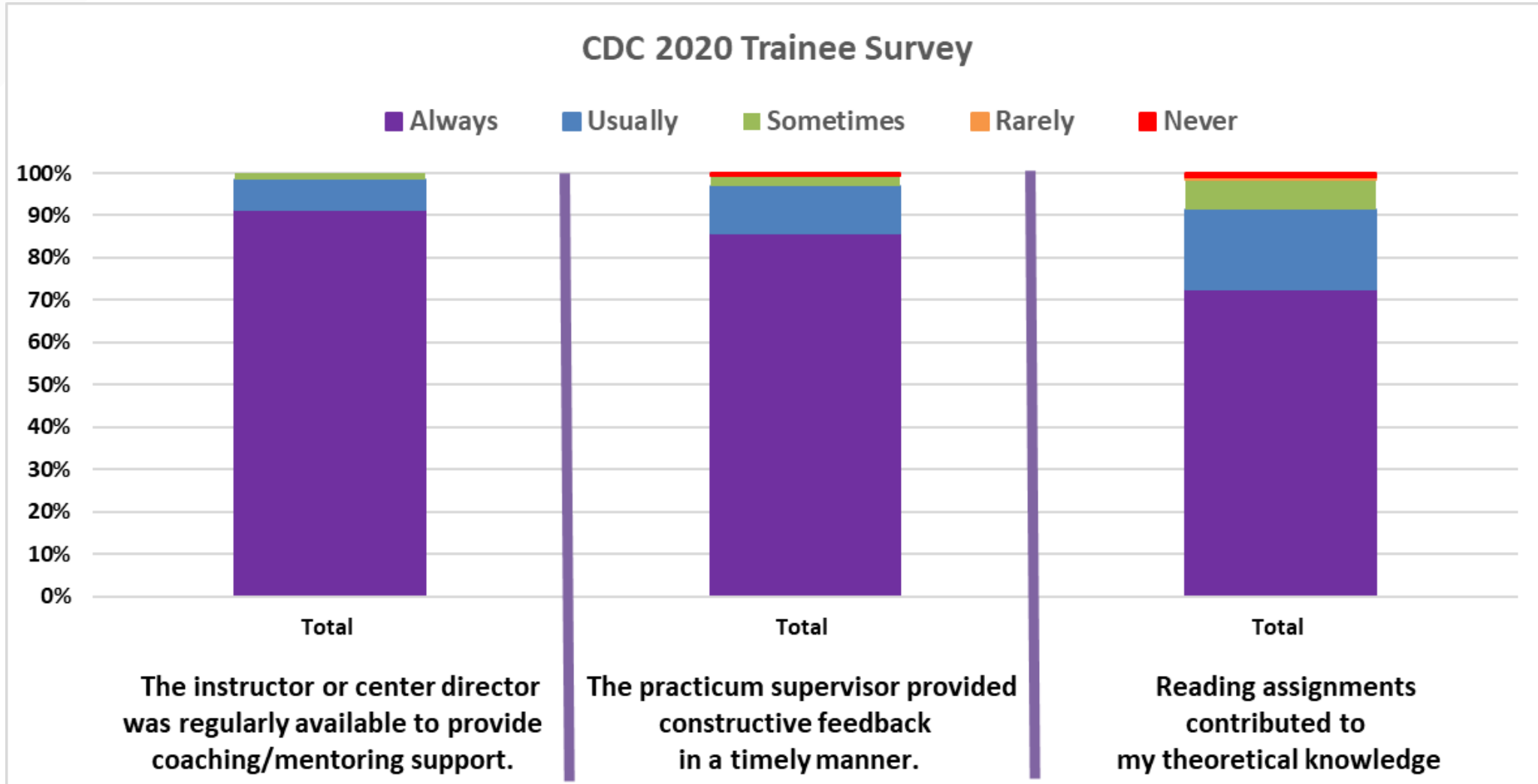
## Knowledge of Instructor, Quality of Materials and Facility
